The Renewal of Parachute Jumping

- 1. APPLIES TO:** **the cancellation of the regulation** issued by the Service Bulletin no. 2/08/2008 - The Suspension of Parachute Jumping related to the parachute systems specified as follows:
 - **the WP -175 reserve parachute**
 - **the OP-087 container, size 4N**
 - **the MPAAD safety device.**

- 2. REASON:** Securing the proper functioning of the system containing the above specified container and reserve parachute based on positive results of the tests performed by the manufacturer.

- 3. MEASURES:** Close the reserve container using a changed way of packing, unlike specified in the current Technical Description P-001-01, 5th issue dated 03/2008, page 28, fig. no. 21 (current way of packing – see Appendix No.1). Perform the packing of the container with the following sequence of flaps: 1-2-3-4-**6-5 (new way of packing)** – see Appendix no. 1).
Insert the release pin of the reserve parachute not more than up to edge of the reinforcement of the flap no. 5 in maximum (see Appendix no. 1 – new way of packing).
The length of the closing line of the reserve parachute set by the manufacturer is 75 ± 5 mm (see Appendix no. 1).

- 4. VALIDITY:** Upon the date of this Bulletin's issue.
